We are a collaborative team who consult with each other frequently, and all benefit from our joint knowledge across several areas of expertise. This is reflected in our weekly meeting structure that strives to protect clinical consultation dialogue from administrative agenda.

We stand with people of color and of oppressed identities. We support the political movements aimed at dismantling racism, improving equality, and increasing diversity of all types. As clinicians and staff, we value a self-reflective practice and supporting one another to push our learning and growing edges. These practices are integrated into our clinical work, ongoing education and training for staff, and our personal lives. We utilize a socio-cultural lens when conceptualizing and understanding our clients' present situations and presenting problems and recognize that not all identities are visible. We acknowledge that white privilege exists, oppression and discrimination are real, and condemn violence against people of color and those experiencing other kinds of oppression. We welcome and encourage applicants of historically marginalized identities to apply.

Responsibilities

- Complete psychological/neuropsychological assessments for children, adolescents, college students, and adults with a wide range of strengths and needs, including learning, mental health and social emotional challenges.
- Conduct collateral interviews as part of a comprehensive evaluation process
- Write comprehensive, well-written reports in a timely fashion
- Work collaboratively with other professionals to integrate findings
- Conduct feedback meetings with clients and families and attend IEP meetings
- Attend weekly in-person clinical staff meetings (Wednesdays 1-2:30pm)
- Attend professional development series and contribute by leading one on a topic of your choosing
- Work with our billing department on documentation for reimbursement from insurance companies and school districts
- Work with our administrative assistance for scheduling
- Other optional and/or possible duties include: providing psychotherapy, facilitating groups, conducting screenings, additional intake sessions, testing at local schools, conducting school observations or FBAs, and supervising doctoral and postdoctoral students in psychology.


Requirements
